CreArtBox is a New York–based chamber music and multimedia ensemble led by flutist Guillermo Laporta and pianist Josefina Urraca, with core members Emilie-Anne Gendron, Matthew Cohen, and Julia Yang. Recognized by *The New Yorker* as one of its “art and music top picks,” praised by *Time Out* as “an ensemble devoted to multidisciplinary events,” and described by *BroadwayWorld* as “wholly authentic, visually and aurally compelling,” CreArtBox is celebrated for performances that merge classical and contemporary music with original stage design and visual art.

The ensemble's work has been supported by the National Endowment for the Arts, the New York State Council on the Arts, the Queens Council on the Arts, the Amphion Foundation, the Alice M. Ditson Fund, and the Aaron Copland Fund for Music. It also runs an open call for scores and a composer residency program, and co-produces *Festival ADAR* in Asturias, Spain — dedicated to revitalizing rural communities through music, residencies, and site-specific projects.
